- White Background ONLY
- No Cursing
- No Logo clothing or Brand names
- Attach your name, address, phone number and email on the Mini DV Tape

Photograph

- Your photograph should be current
- Include on the back of the photograph your name, age, hometown, and the branch of Armed Forces that previously denied your service
- Please describe the reasons why you were previously denied enlistment

Complete Package

- Along with your Video and Photograph, provide a copy of your ID or Driver's License (Moto Entertainment needs to verify the age of all participants)
